Western Iowa Advantage Partners held their September meeting at the newly opened Waspy's Truck Stop in Audubon. Partners met with Waspy's Chief Operating Officer, Beth Handlos and Chief Executive Officer, Brian Handlos, who provided an overview of the Waspy's projects in Audubon and in Templeton.

Waspy's Truck Stop in Audubon is located just south of Audubon on Highway 71 on 16-plus acres and consists of: convenience store, grab & go kitchen, grocery products, multiple fuel options, certified scale with five-axle capacity, semi parking, trucker lounge, car wash and RV station. The

Feed Mill Restaurant and Blue Grass Inn & Suites also are located in the complex. Waspy's in Audubon has 92 employees and ideally employment will grow to 130, once complete. The Waspy's complex in Audubon represents a \$20 Million investment and a \$7 million project investment in Templeton.

Iowa's Unemployment Rate Remains at 2.5% in September

The Western Iowa Advantage Region's monthly unemployment rate decreased to 1.9 percent in September 2018 from 2.8 percent in May 2018, according to figures released from Iowa Workforce Development. Iowa's unemployment rate was 2.5 percent in September 2018 from 3.0 percent in September 2017. The U.S. unemployment rate was 3.7 percent in September 2017. Total employment in the region increased to 45,440 in September 2018 from 38,000 in September 2017.


